criminalize same-sex marriage throughout Nigeria. The West ought to stop using aid as a means of coercion and financial assistance to changing public policy. We want to salute with standing ovation Hon. George Blamoh Wesseh of Grand Kru County, Hon. Prince Tokpah of Nimba County, Hon. Edward Karfiah of Bong County, Cllr. Jerome Verdier, Rev. Peter Fahn Kollie, Sr. and other reputable opinion leaders who have preliminarily vowed to fight against gay and lesbian rights bill at the Capitol Building.

I admonish all lawmakers, government officials and persons of great integrity to join the boat of Anti-Gay Campaigners and make public their commitment to relentlessly wage war against homosexuality and lesbianism. personalities of prominence should make!!

The “End Time” must not reach to the door post of Liberia in such an absurd manner. Change will only come if we live in accordance with God’s principles. Change will only prevail if we abide by God’s Holy ordinance for a Marital Union. I call on all married and unmarried people in this Nation to protect their interest before it’s too late. If we don’t do so, the word Marriage which is attributed to a union of opposite sex will soon be attached to them (Gays). Let this not happen during our lifetime and even the lifetime of our children’s children. If you are a man and still have the belief that you shall one day get married to another man, drop that belief now!! If you are a woman and still have the thought that you shall one day have protection and security under our law to marry another woman, drop that thought now!!! Neither Montserrado nor Maryland will accept that.

Recently, Liberia found herself on the platform of international recognition by producing dual Nobel Peace Prize Laureates. President Ellen Johnson Sirleaf and Madam Leymah Boywee were proud to receive those awards because of their role played in advocating against social vices. This is the time for them to really prove to the world that the awards given them were meritorious. I strongly share similar view with others that the worst vice is homosexuality. Our aspiration five years from now is not to see a country of gays, but to envisage a State of faithful diplomats, lawmakers, professors, teachers, pastors, lawyers, doctors, engineers, scientists, activists, journalists, administrators, economists, agriculturists and others who will defend the precept of moral superiority.

Legally, homosexuality is offensive and unrecognizable in Liberia. People who practice this habit are not protected under the law of Liberia. It is cleared that Gays-homosexuals/lesbians have no rights to carry on such deviant social acts as prohibited under the Statutes and Constitution of the Republic of Liberia. While it may be true that the Constitution provides for freedom of thought... which implies that one has the right to engage in those activities that he or she feels are intended to satisfy his or her desire but on the other hand, the same Constitution under Article 14, Paragraph (1) frowns on those things that are inimical (unfavorable) to public safety, order, or morals, or health or the fundamental rights and freedom of another. In view of this, Gay life is inconsistent with the Statutes and Constitution of Liberia, and therefore, there is no room for such activities. Hence, those who practice such deviant sexual acts (Gay-life) in Liberia are doing so illegally and must stop now!! Research findings revealed that some of the people who engage in such practice in Liberia, do so for economic, social and political reasons and as a way of climbing the social ladder

in society. Interestingly, this practice is prevalent among top public and private officials who entice young people (males/females) to indulge into such habit. On the other hand, others do so to satisfy their sexual desires. Most Gays are drug addicts. Gay-life became public knowledge in Liberia due to cultural interaction as people from Europe and America took up assignments in Liberia, including those Liberians who returned from abroad.

Under the statutes and Constitution of the Republic of Liberia, there is no provision for Gays-homosexuals/lesbians. However, under the Penal Law of Liberia, there is a provision for ‘SODOMY’, which is considered an offence and is very close to Gays-homosexuals/lesbians

from its legal stand.

According to Section 14.72 'AGGRAVATED INVOLUNTARY SODOMY' of the Penal Law of Liberia which provides that:

A person who engages in deviate sexual intercourse with another, or who causes another to engage in deviate sexual intercourse, has committed an offence if: He compels the other to submit by force or by threats of imminent death, serious bodily injury, or kidnapping, to be inflicted on any human being;

He has substantially impaired the other person's power to appraise or control his or her conduct by administering or employing without his or her knowledge intoxicates or other means with the intent to prevent resistance; or The other person is less than sixteen years of age, provided the actor is sixteen years or older.

Accordingly, the offence is first degree felony if in the course of the offence the actor inflicts serious bodily injury upon the other person, or if his conduct violates paragraph 1)(c) of this Section, or if the other person is not a voluntary companion of the actor and has not previously permitted his sexual liberties. Otherwise, the offence is a second degree felony.

Under Section 14.73 'INVOLUNTARY SODOMY' of the Penal Law, which provides that a person who engages in deviate sexual intercourse with another person, or who causes another to engage in deviate sexual intercourse, has committed a third degree felony if: He knows that the other person suffers from mental disease or defect which renders him or her incapable of understanding the nature of his or her conduct: He knows that the other person is unaware that a sexual act is being committed upon him or her;

He compels the other person to submit by any threat that would render a person of reasonable firmness incapable of resisting. Further to the above, Section 14.74, 'VOLUNTARY SODOMY' of the Penal Law provides that a person who engages in deviate sexual intercourse under circumstances not stated in Section 14.72 or 14.73 has committed a first degree misdemeanour.

Accordingly, Gays (homosexuals/lesbians) are individuals (males/females) who engage in deviate sexual intercourse with their sex mates or members of the opposite sex. Gay, being synonymous or close to Sodomy, is defined by the Penal Law of Liberia, as a deviate sexual activity and is therefore considered an offence under Liberian laws. We want to publicly acknowledge the hard work of Legal Aid Incorporated from whom the outcomes of our legal research were obtained. I encourage all legal organizations and firms in this country to follow the examples of LAI by producing legal papers and publishing laws that oppose homosexuality.

We remain confident in the wisdom of our legal practitioners and jurists who will not allow such an inflammatory act to creep in our judicial sector. Let our Laws continue to speak against them (Gays).

In conclusion, I want to recommend the following that will highly discourage any attempt of initiating a bill to promote gay-rights. The bi-cameral legislature of Liberia enacts a law that will

make gay-marriage and lesbianism illegal and criminal in nature. The government allots an annual amount of 500,000.00 USD to support the anti-gay campaign in Liberia. (All Anti-gay movements be subsidized to remain devoted in their fight against same-sex marriage).

The government establishes a rigorous Task Force or Special Unit to expose and arrest Gays and lesbians who are operating underground. The views and opinions of so-called gay-advocates be barred and banished totally from the Liberia society. Anyone caught in the act of homosexuality be arrested and prosecuted. If found guilty be imprisoned for twenty years with treatment of hard labor.

Anyone caught promoting gayism and lesbianism through any medium be arrested and prosecuted; and if found guilty be imprisoned for ten (10) years with treatment of hard labor. Anti-gay lessons be embedded in Health Sciences of our National Curriculum for our students in primary, secondary, and tertiary institutions to know the dangers of same-sex marriage.

We are of the conviction that if the aforementioned are put in place, the voices of homosexuals and lesbians will not resurrect, even on the day of judgment.
